- -add request to Web site visitors to send us e-mail so an exhibition invitation could be sent to them. (not required as members already get emails)
- -re-organize home page for easier viewing without scrolling. (Not really useful as the items would be too small to read.)
- -add sponsor bar to home page which could be rented out. (Researching this)
- -Add YouTube to home page YouTube links are added in the events photos.
- -add member interviews with video player or flash. (not required)
- -add tutorials for member instruction. (Possibility depending upon members volunteering services)
- -add a blog to the Web site. (Digest is a blog)
