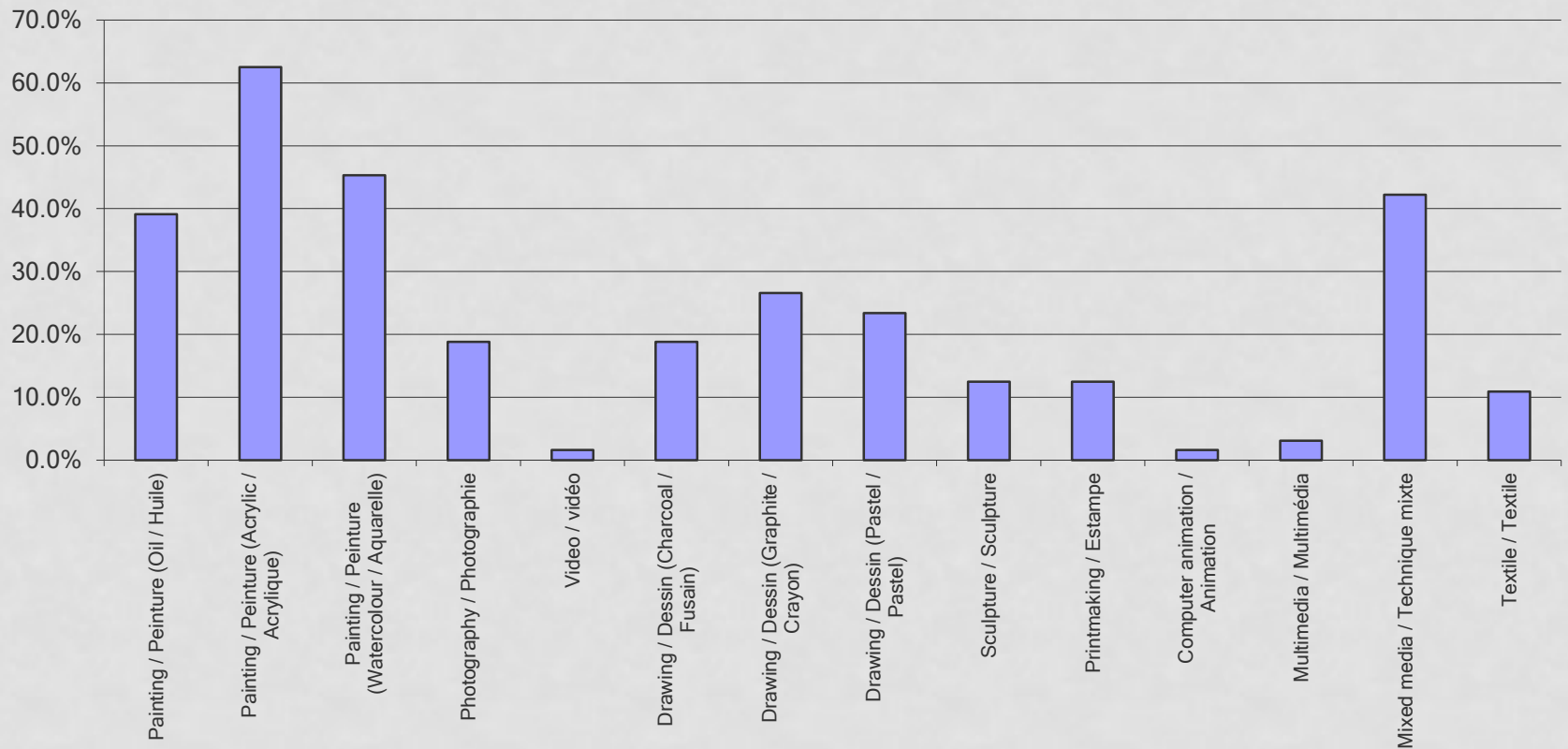
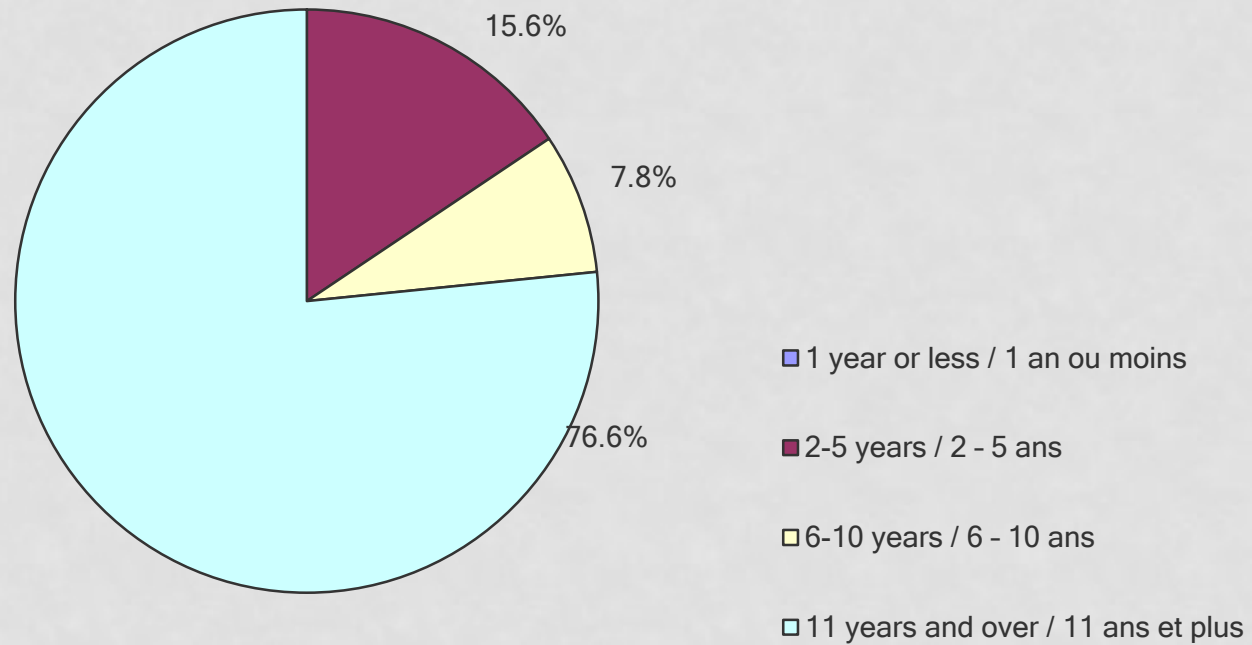

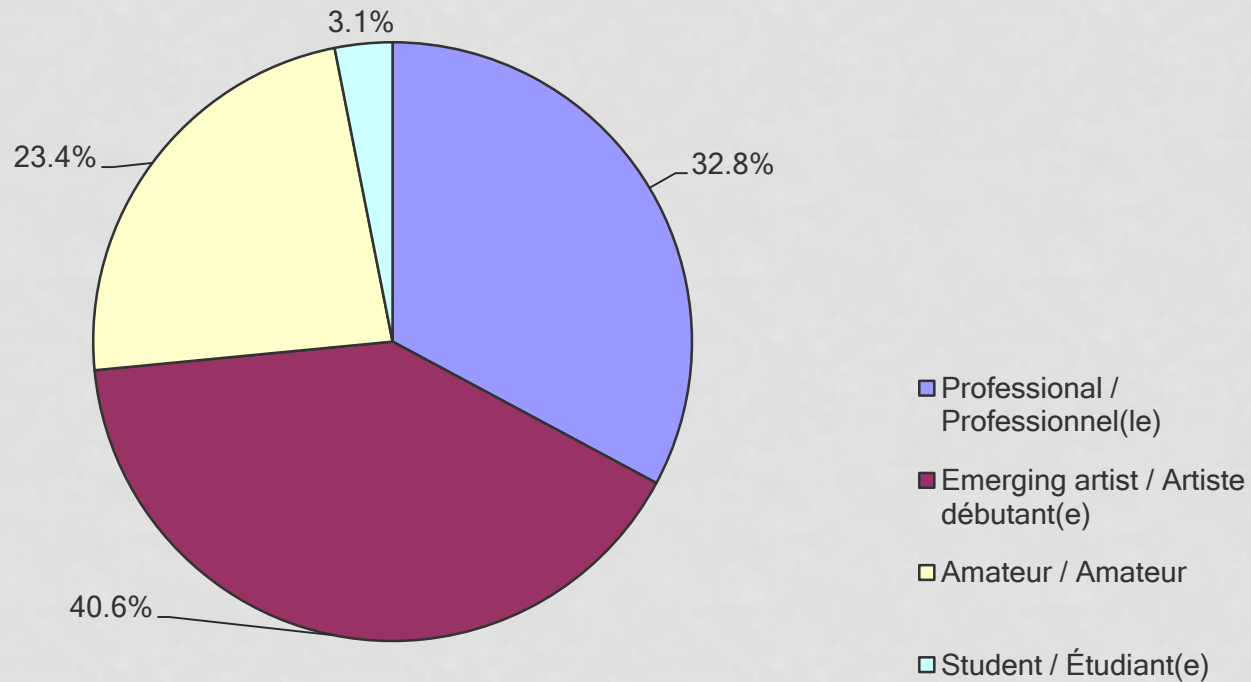
# Which medium do you work in? / Avec quel médium travaillez-vous?



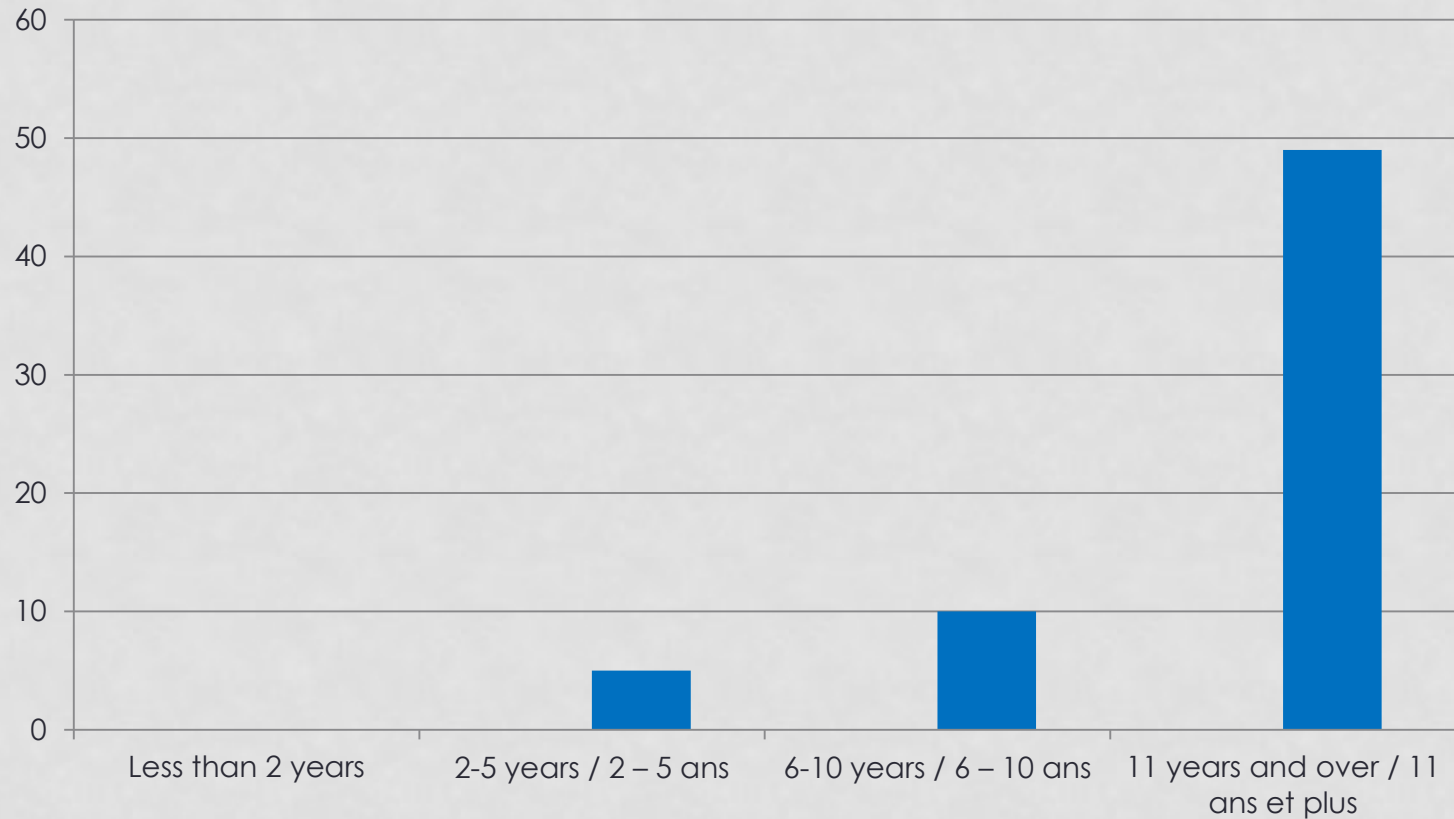
# How long have you been involved in art making? / Depuis combien de temps faites-vous des arts?



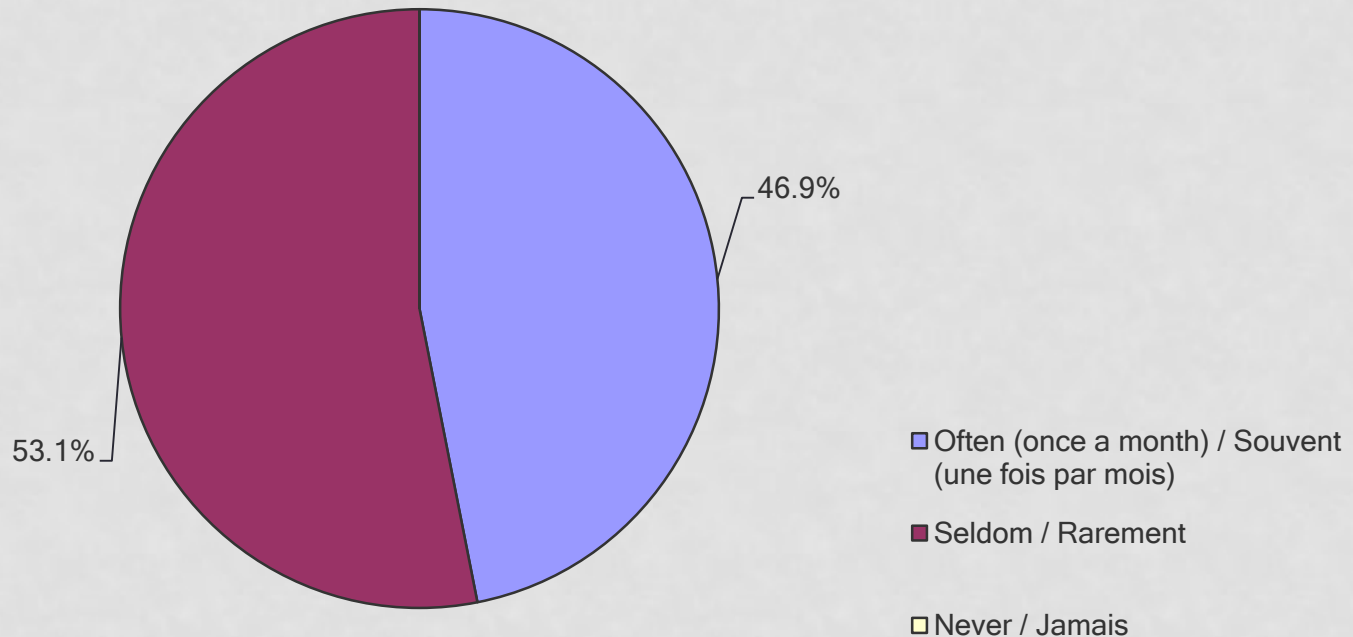
# How would you describe yourself as an artist? / Comment vous décrivez-vous comme artiste?



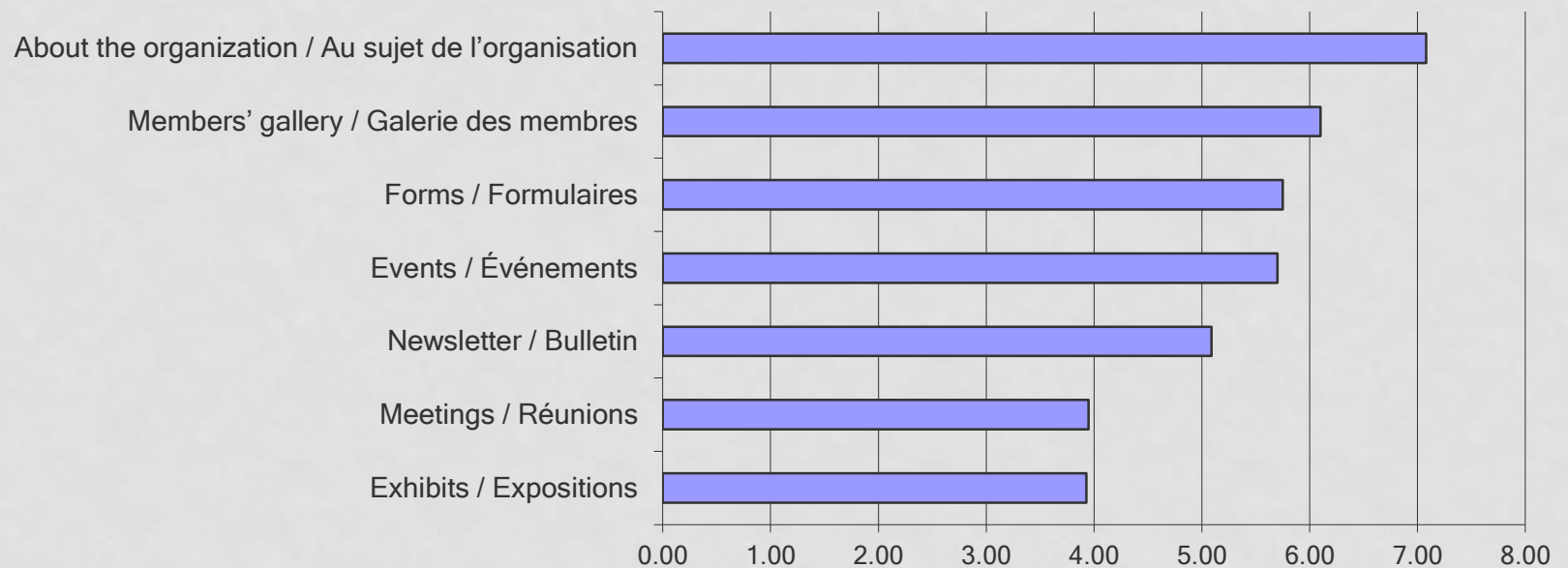
How many years have you been a member of Arteast? /  
Depuis combien d'année êtes-vous membre d'Arteast?



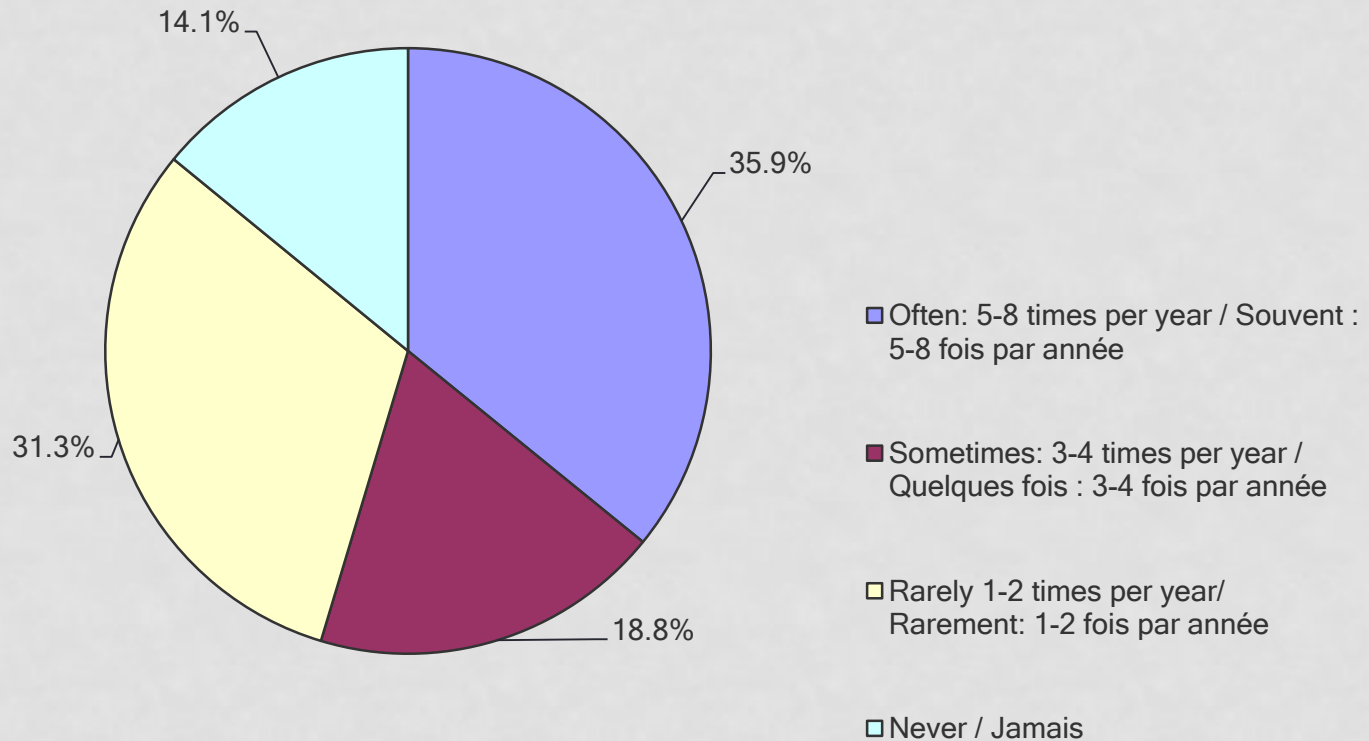
# How often do you visit Arteast's website? / Combien de fois visitez-vous le site web d'Arteast?

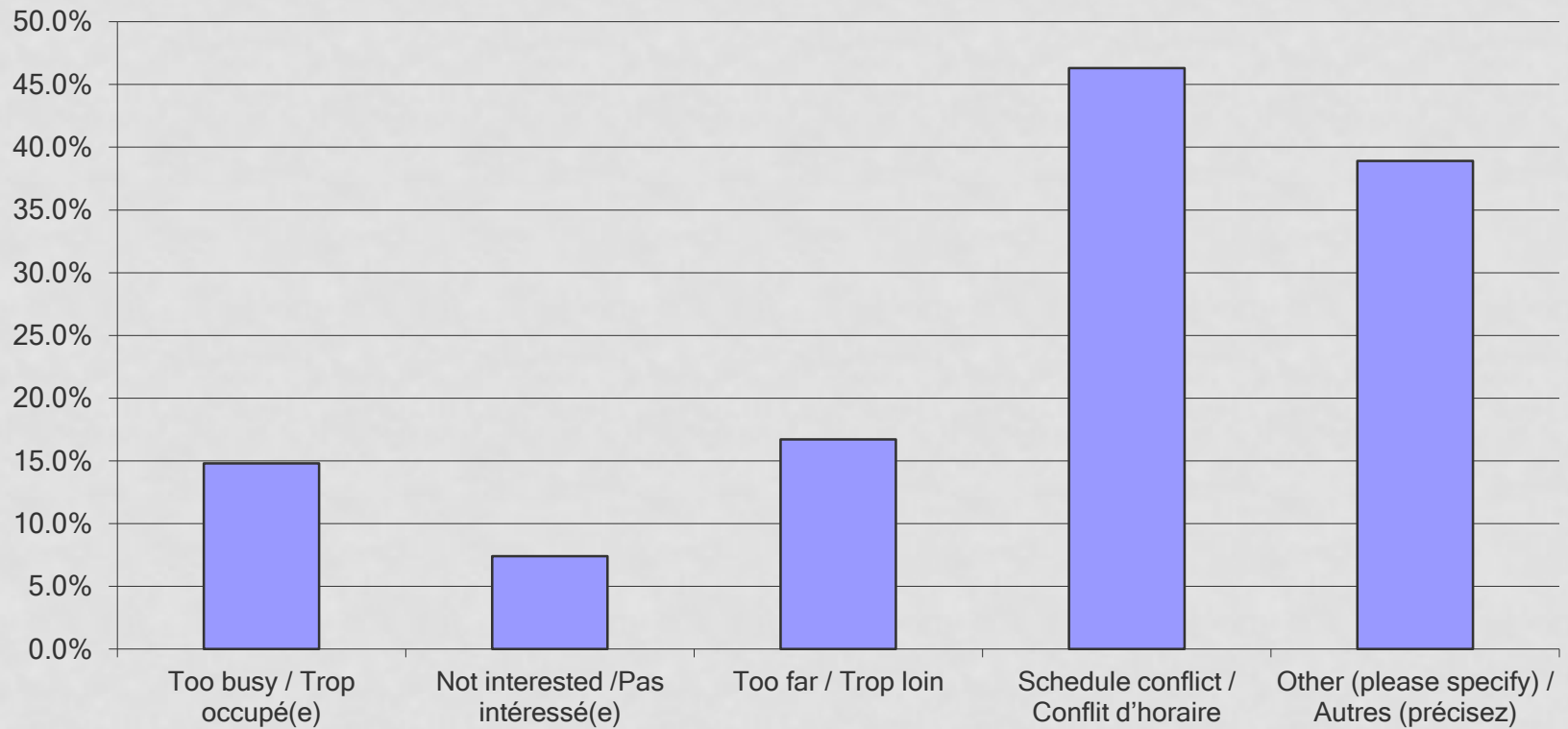


# How often do you attend Arteast General meetings / Combien de fois assistez-vous aux réunions générales d'Arteast?





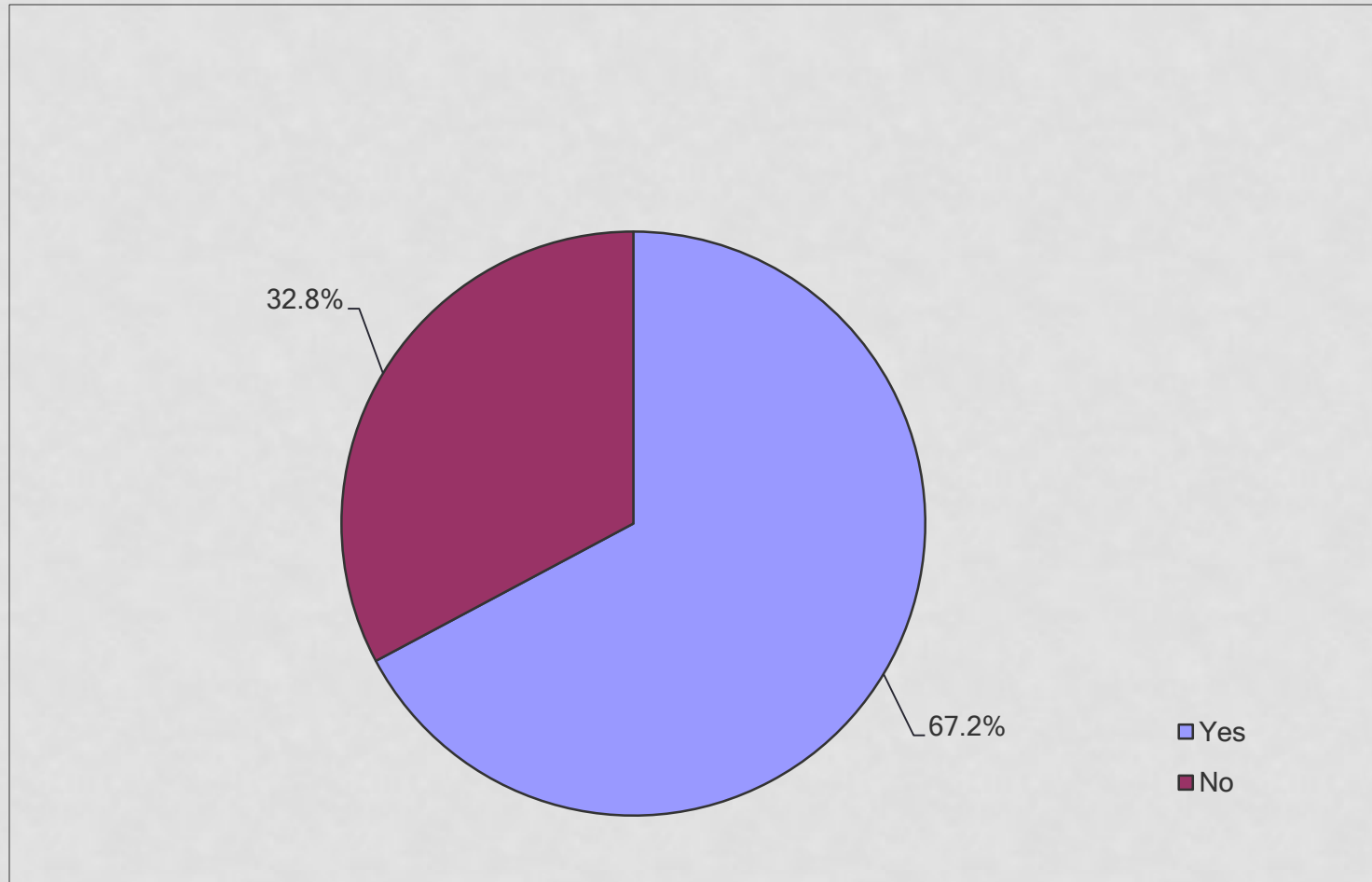

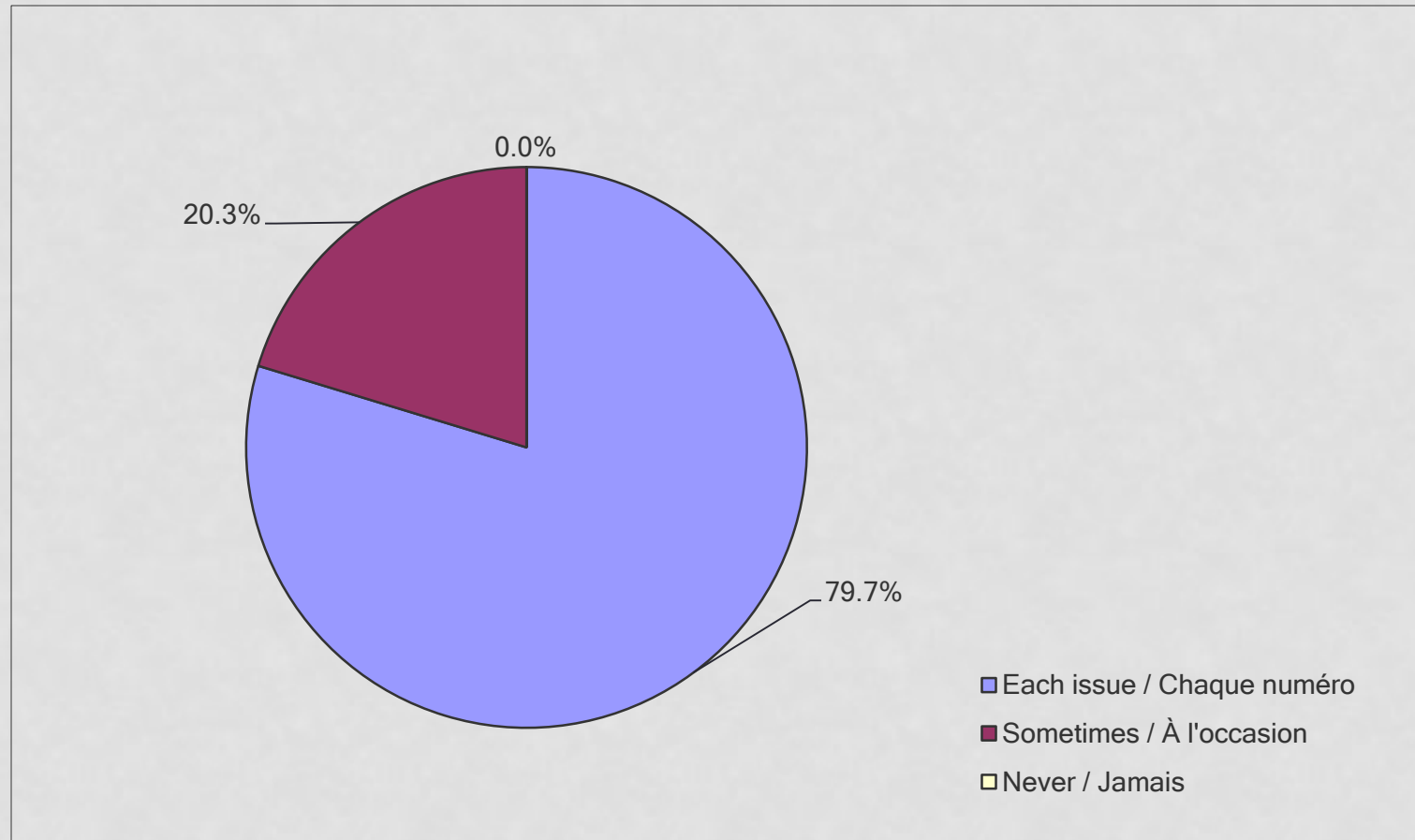
# How many hours per month can you volunteer? / Combien d'heures par mois pouvez-vous faire du bénévolat?

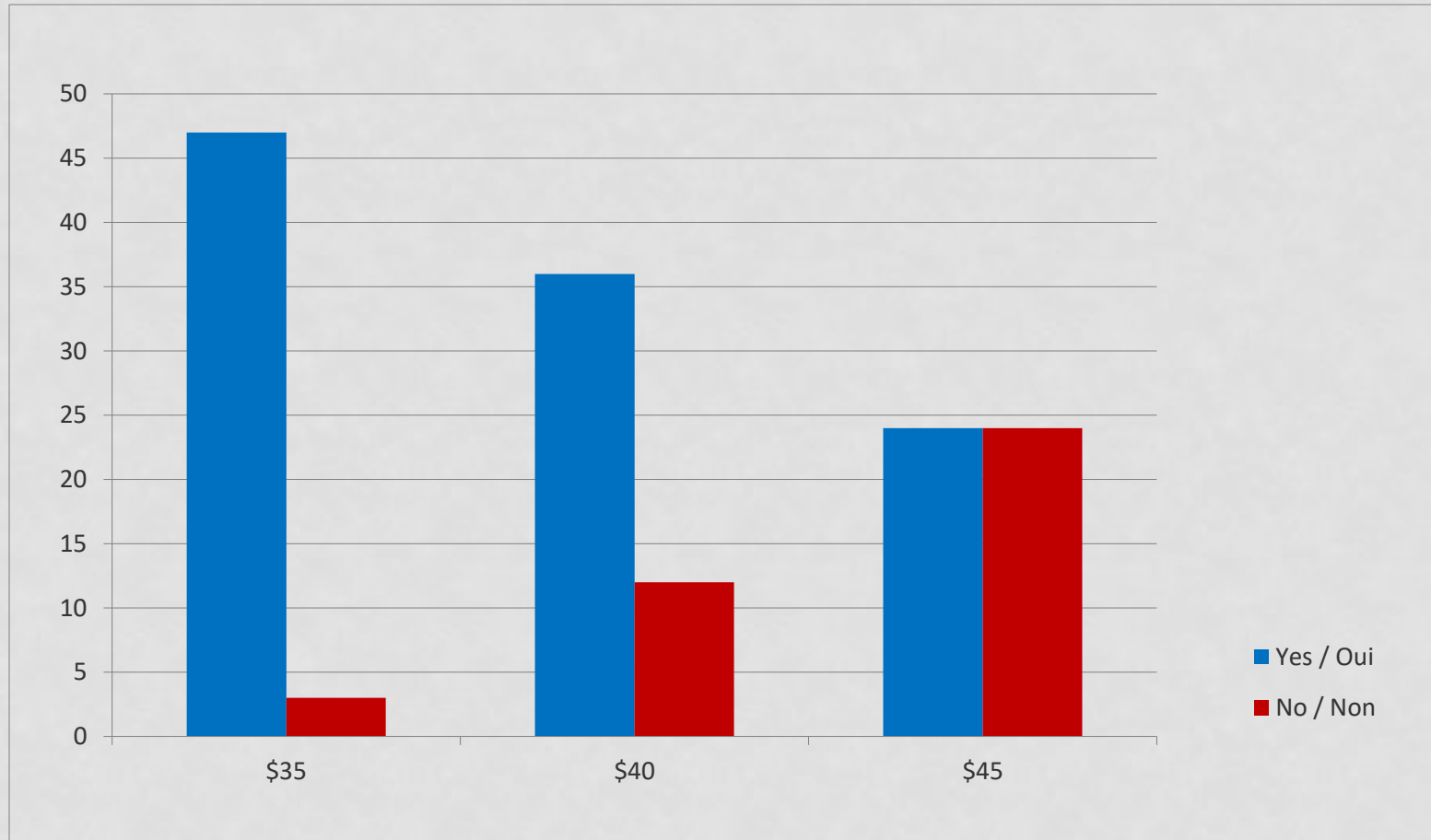


Which format of the Communiqué do you read? / Vous lisez le Communiqué sous quel format?





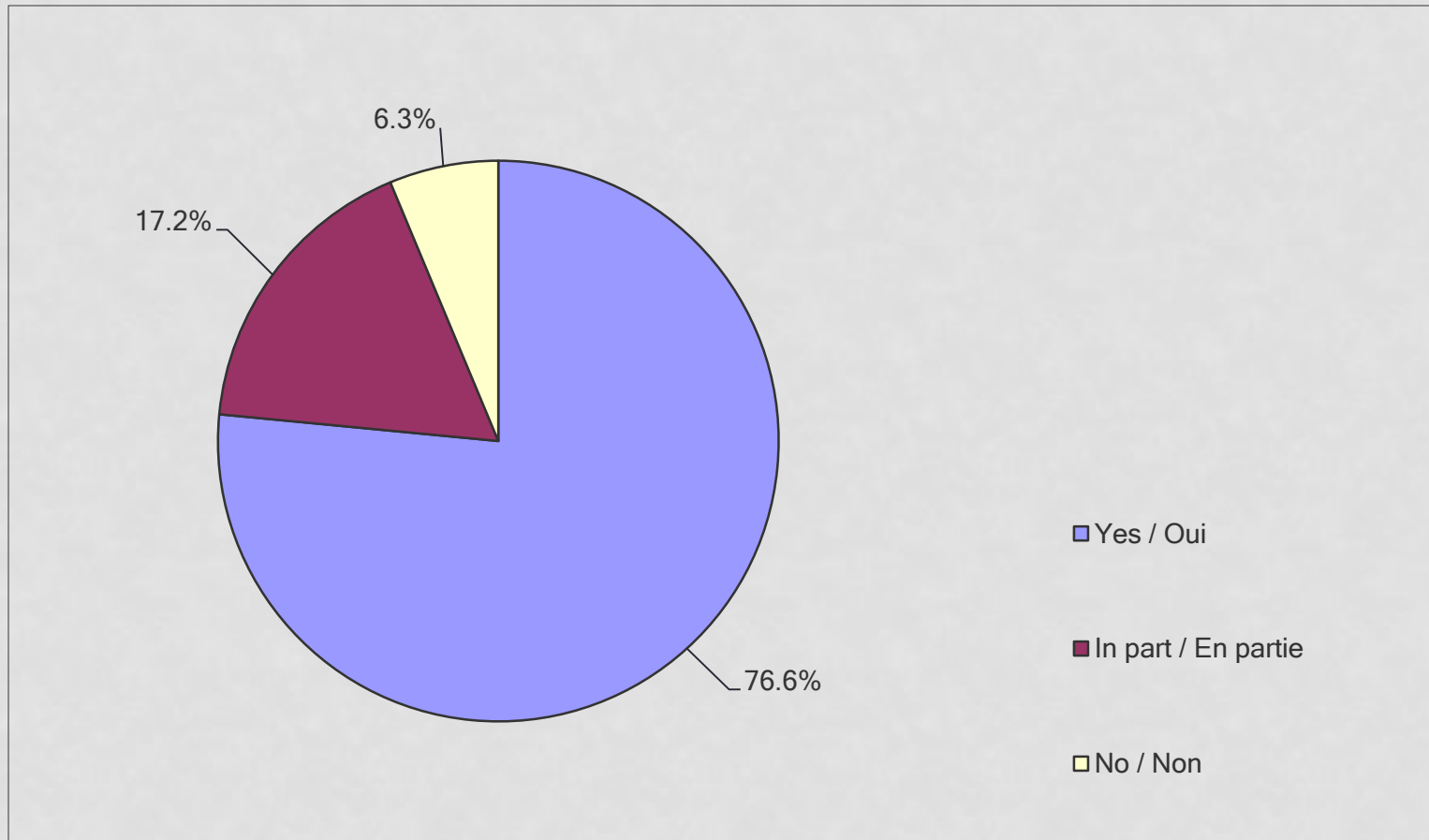
